The Awards are open to:

- **Science Technicians in schools and colleges for students up to 18**
- **Science Technicians with five or more years experience**

The Criteria for the Awards are:

- **The range and depth of the technician's influence on decisions in the department, developing experiments, involvement in schemes of work, setting standards including safety, stock control, working in classrooms, advising teachers, NQTs, PGCE students and students**
- **Being systematic about their own development (where possible) e.g. attending courses, becoming an expert in ICT**
- **Being systematic about managing and developing the skills of other technicians in their institutions, where applicable**
- **Being key people in innovations and activities linked to the science department e.g. clubs, fieldwork visits**
- **Interacting with other technicians e.g. from other schools, local groups, ASE**
- **Helping the school in other ways e.g. participating in the general life of the school**

How to nominate:

- A nomination form may be obtained from the address overleaf, by email, telephone or downloading from our website
- The form should be completed by the Head Teacher or Head of Science and returned to the Salters' Institute no later than the closing date
- A technician who has been nominated on a previous occasion but was not successful can be nominated again, providing he or she still meets the criteria
- If a technician is being re-nominated then a new form must be completed
